Wigan Town Centre

19 High-spec public realm trees

- Part of Wigan Town Heritage Initiative regenerating town centre
- Investing in high quality public realm for local shops and businesses to invest / remain

A6 Corridor

27 main road , residential and green space trees

- Links to Frederick Rd scheme
- Partnership with Irwell Valley Housing Association – complementing investment into housing stock
- Encourages recreational use of local parks

Frederick Road Salford

36 main road and green space trees

- improving routeway along busy industrial road used by students walking to/ from University of Salford and City College Salford
- encourage investment into Salford Innovation Centre
- encourage walkers / cyclists to use Irwell River Walkway
- links to The Meadows and Spike Island tree planting plus Newlands Green Streets in Salford

Salford Crescent

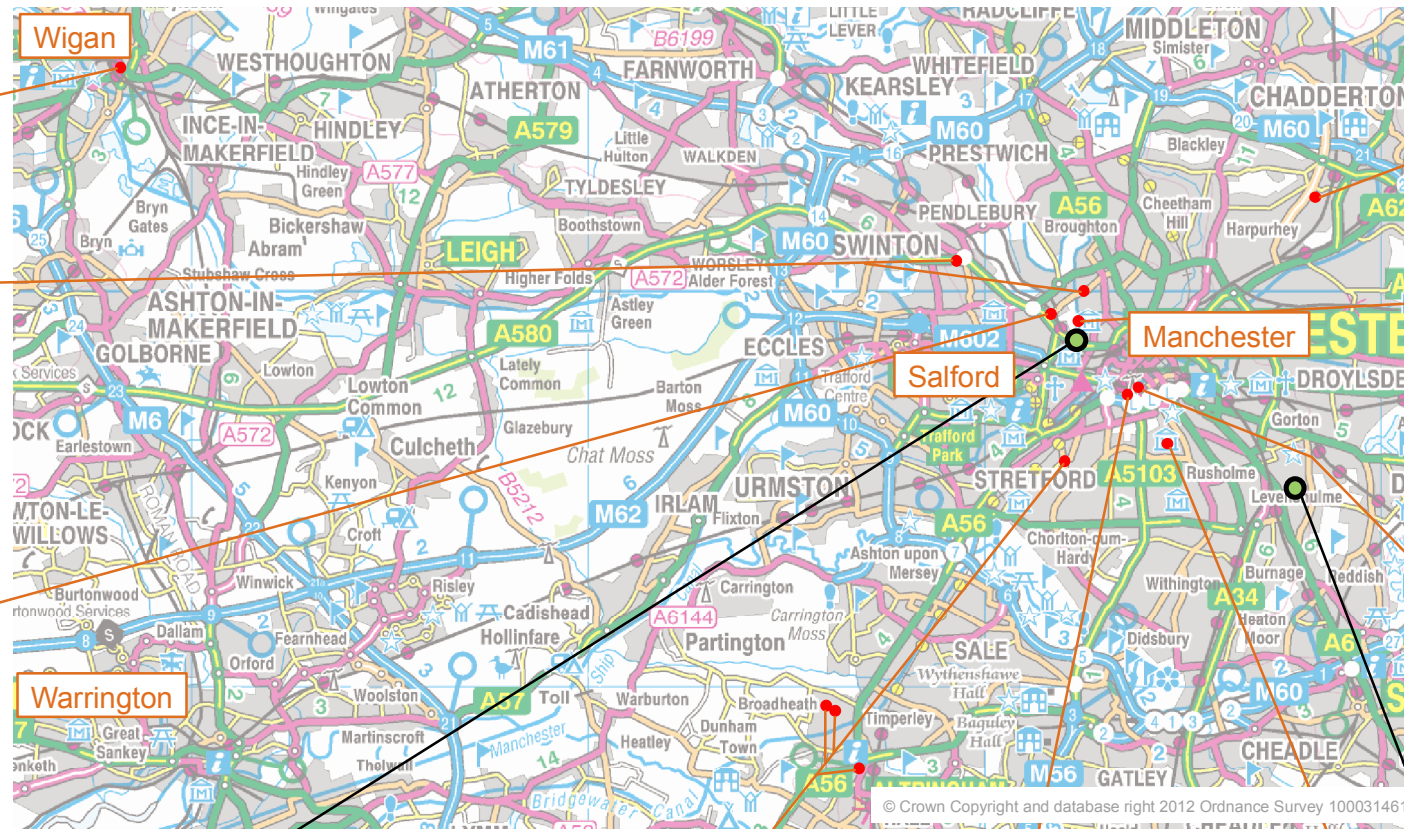
Size: 7 hectares

Location: Broughton, Salford

Contribution: £185k

Regeneration has

- helped address the needs of a national top 2% deprived ward
- supported the regeneration of Chapel Street/A6 by providing a diverse and attractive landscape
- augmented the University of Salford Masterplan by providing new recreational and teaching facilities
- involved local communities in new activities, building community capacity and resilience



Trafford Priority Areas

130 High-spec public realm and residential trees

- Investment into high IMD areas
- Partnership with Trafford Council
- High resident buy-in enabling more tree planting in area with previously few trees
- High density residential area greened significantly
- Altrincham Town Centre improved, kickstarting programme of greening to regenerate local centre

Oxford Rd Corridor

29 high-spec public realm trees

- Major improvements to appearance of busy roads in City Centre
- Strong support from local businesses
- Attracted significant match from Council, s106 and Interreg
- Links to emerging City Centre Green & Blue Infrastructure Plan

Moston

47 main road , residential and green space trees

- Links to Moston Vale and Moston Brook and tips
- Planting outside primary and secondary schools – encourages walking and traffic calming
- Green signposting to Nuthurst Park and Broadhurst Park
- Strong community support from residents and school

Spike Island

45 residential and green space trees

- partnership with Environment Agency via Climate Change Action Plan in high flood risk area
- encourages use of The Meadows by green signposting
- Links to The Meadows, Frederick Rd trees + Newlands Salford schemes

Whitworth St West

16 high-spec public realm trees

- Major improvements to appearance of busy but unattractive road, linking Oxford Rd and Deansgate
- Strong support from local businesses
- Attracted significant match from Council, s106 and Interreg

Matthews Lane

Size: 13 hectares

Location: Gorton South, Manchester

Contribution: £355k

Regeneration has

- helped address the needs of a national top 1% deprived ward
- turned a neglected brownfield site into a busy and well maintained resource
- supported Housing Market Renewal by removing eyesores, flytipping and antisocial behaviour
- provided a focus for community engagement and activism

Dilworth St

15 High spec public realm trees

- Improves important cycle/walking link to University of Manchester campus
- Part of i-trees - Interreg-supported research into street tree specs and GI benefits of trees
